Getting there You can get to Stone Pde (gps: -33.7373, 151.1962) by car or bus. Car: There is free parking available. This is a return, so you will finish back at the start.

0 | Stone Pde

(950 m 22 mins) From the intersection, the walk passes through the metal gate marked with the Cascades Track sign, and follows the (initially) asphalted service trail. The service trail winds down into the valley, steeply at times, until it comes to the signposted intersection with the French's Creek Track.

0.95 | Int of Cascades and Frenchs Creek service trails

(570 m 11 mins) Continue straight: From the intersection, this walk follows the service trail, leaving the French's Creek track to the right. The walk descends before following a creek for a short distance to the cascades.

1.51 | The Cascades

The Cascades are a series of small cascades (little waterfalls) in Garigal National Park. The cascades centre around a large rock platform on Middle Harbour Creek and are found in the northern section of the park, at the intersection of the Middle Harbour and Cascade Tracks. The cascades make a great spot to sit and rest when exploring the area.
